For entry into the minutes, on January 5, 2010, pursuant to Racing, Pari-Mutuel Wagering and Breeding Law Section 322, the New York State Racing and Wagering Board approved a request by American Racing-Vernon Downs, Inc. to expand the Slot Tech Storage area in their Video Gaming Building as described in their letter and the building permit dated December 7, 2009 from the Town of Vernon.

Accordingly, the Board certified that Finger Lakes, Batavia Downs, Buffalo Raceway, Monticello Raceway, Saratoga Harness, Vernon Downs, and Yonkers Raceway have complied with either Section 236(3)(b)(ii) or Section 318(5)(b)(ii) of the Racing, Pari-Mutuel Wagering and Breeding Law for the purpose of establishing the 2009 pari-mutuel tax rate.
