Pursuant to Racing, Pari-Mutuel Wagering and Breeding Law Section 318 (5), the Board found that it would have been uneconomical or impractical for American Racing-Vernon Downs, Inc. to be assigned the prescribed number of racing dates [Section 318(5)(b)(i).] Therefore, such finding entitles this harness racetrack to be classified as if it did comply with the required number of pari-mutuel programs and races at its facilities to establish eligibility for the tax rates set forth in Section 318(1).

4. **TIOGA DOWNS – 2009 TRACK & SIMULCAST LICENSE APPLICATIONS**

On May 27, 2009, the New York State Racing and Wagering Board granted the American Racing-Tioga Downs, Inc. track and simulcast licenses for 2009.

The Board assigned the remainder of the 57 racing programs requested on the dates specified and at the post-times requested. The Board approved plans relating to the Magnetic Media Storage (Rule 5100.5), Totalisator Room Security (Rule 5100.23[d]), and Posting of Race Results (Rule 5100.11).

5. **BUFFALO RACEWAY – REQUEST TO CONSTRUCT NEW VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY**

On May 27, 2009, the New York State Racing and Wagering Board approved a permit, in accordance with Section 322 of the Racing, Pari-Mutuel Wagering and Breeding Law, for Buffalo Trotting Association, Inc./Buffalo Raceway to construct a foundation for VLT related building expansion as described in the April 27, 2009 building permit issued by the New York State Office of General Services (Project No. S4493). Buffalo Trotting Association, Inc./ Buffalo Raceway must submit a request to the Board and receive approval along with construction permits from OGS prior to the start of other phases of construction of the VLT facility.

6. **NEW YORK CITY OTB – REQUEST TO EXTEND INTER- FACE AGREEMENT WITH SCIENTIFIC GAMES**

The New York State Racing and Wagering Board approved an amendment to the New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation’s plan of operation to reflect the extension of an agreement between NYCOTB and Scientific Games Racing, LLC for interface services to be provided by Scientific Games LLC for NYCOTBC in relation to the tracks at which Scientific Games is the totalisator services provider. This amendment extends the terms of the existing agreement though December 31, 2009.

The Board specifically conditioned this approval on NYCOTB’s satisfaction of Rule 5100.2(b)(1), including the requirement that the off-track betting corporation’s totalisator system be in compliance with Rule 5100.24(1)-Independent Monitoring System.

The New York State Racing and Wagering Board (“Board”) approved the New York Racing Association Inc.’s (NYRA) request to display archived video on [www.belmontstakes.com](http://www.belmontstakes.com) as described in the correspondence to the Board dated April 13, 2009 and May 1, 2009. This approval is conditioned on:

- NYRA following the controls and procedures provided in the April 16, 2008, April 28, 2008 and July 23, 2008 letters to the Board, including the requirement of a time stamped log of replays regarding the Board’s June 24, 2008 approval for video streaming,

- NYRA's disclosure to the Board within three days after authorization of the names of those tracks that consent to allow NYRA to display their race replays on NYRA's web sites.

This approval does ***not*** allow NYRA to display live video or audio streaming of NYRA or "non-NYRA" races on NYRA's web site.
