## Statement of Work - #2

This Statement of Work includes requested additional options in accordance with the Full Service Lottery System Agreement (Contract #C080005) entered into by and between the New York State Division of the Lottery and GTECH CORPORATION.

Detailed description of option, enhanced services, system upgrades, required support or maintenance:

## Lottery Vending Machine (LVM):

GTECH to provide the Gemini Ultra Lottery Vending Machine (LVM) that combines the services of an instant ticket vending machine and an on-line self-service terminal. This LVM shall be network connected to the central system. The LVM will support the sale of six (6) New York Lottery games through push button features and all on-line games via playcard through the included interface and there shall be at least twenty-four (24) bins for instant tickets.

The Gemini Ultra will include all features outlined in Attachment A. Specifically, the Unit must include the ability to read New York Driver License or Identification card barcodes to activate the sale of tickets. The feature will be expanded on an agreed upon schedule to include the licenses/cards of other states. Also, this feature will be configurable down to the LVM level. The unit must have a bill accepter that permits all legal US tender up to a \$100 bill (a configurable feature) and include a 2-d barcode reader; remote fob; and ability for reinvestment of proceeds from validated New York lottery tickets.

The price shall be \$92.71 per week, beginning upon delivery, for 260 weeks totaling \$24,104.60 per unit based on an initial order level of 1,000 and subsequent orders of at least 500 and includes the hardware and software, installation, and service (maintenance and repair or replacement) for the initial term of the contract.

It is understood by both parties that if the initial term of the contract has less than 260 weeks remaining, the amount of the payments by the Lottery will be increased in order for GTECH to recapture the full cost over the shorter time period.
