Exhibit VIII.A.14.b - Disciplinary Actions Brought

Submit as Exhibit VIII.A.14.b. a description of any disciplinary action brought against an Applicant Party by any gaming licensing authority during the past five (5) years.

On May 6, 2013 SW Gaming, LLC d/b/a Harlow's Casino Resort & Hotel (Harlow's), a subsidiary of Churchill Downs Incorporated (CDI), received a show cause notice from the Mississippi Gaming Commission (MGC). The notice related to three acts or omissions deemed to be in violation of Mississippi gaming regulations. The three violations were: (1) failure to report a disputed jackpot pay-off, (2) failure to remove multiple slot machines with rescinded software, and (3) failure to make timely notice of an issue dealing with key control. On May 24, 2013, representatives from Harlow's and CDI appeared before the MGC to address the violations. As a result of the hearing, the MGC issued a \$5,000 fine. No further administrative actions were taken.
