

Exhibit VIII.C.20.b – Proposed Closures

Submit as Exhibit VIII.C.20.b. a description of anticipated street and sidewalk closures, plans for redirecting traffic, impacts on existing parking, if any, noise and dust impacts, and plans for mitigating such impacts both during and following construction. Describe measures that will be taken to mitigate all construction impacts on the local community.

Two-way traffic on NYS Route 4 will be maintained at all times during construction. No off site detours will be required. The work on NYS Route 4 generally consists of pavement widening along the east side of the road, which will require that traffic lanes be temporarily shifted to provide adequate room for delineators and for construction operations. Access to all adjacent commercial properties, both vehicular and pedestrian, will be required by the contract documents. Emergency vehicles will be allowed clear access to all side streets and commercial plaza entrances in the project limits during construction. The work zone traffic control will be coordinated with local officials, emergency response agencies, and business owners during the final design stages.
