EXHIBIT VIII.C.9.b - Marketing of Entertainment Venues

Submit as Exhibit VIII.C.9.b. a description of how the entertainment venues proposed for the Project Site are distinguished (whether by design or intended use) and intended to complement the impacted live entertainment venues identified pursuant to Item IX.B.2.

As described in Exhibit VIII.C.8.a, Capital View Casino & Resort is designed with a single, versatile location for a wide range of meetings, entertainment and player-related events. A 6,000-square-foot special events hall will accommodate 500 people for concerts and 270 people for banquet-style events.

At a very early stage, we made the decision to limit our event space to that which will not compete with the impacted live entertainment venues as described in Item IX.B.2. The multi-use space does not include fixed seating, nor the sound, lighting and back of house components necessary to produce the live performances that are the specialty of these venues.

Rather than offer a competing product, our plan is to work with these venues to provide partnerships specifically designed to complement their offerings and packages that will drive increased visitation to all facilities. These programs are further described in Exhibit VIII.C.9.c.
