Steven Orbuch is a Founder, President and Senior Principal of Och-Ziff Real Estate ("OZRE") and a member of OZRE's Investment Committee. Prior to forming OZRE in 2003, Mr. Orbuch was a Managing Director with Blackstone Real Estate Advisors ("Blackstone") where he participated in the sourcing, acquisition and financing of over \$2 billion of commercial properties across multiple product types and geographic locations. Mr. Orbuch played a significant role in helping to invest capital on behalf of all of Blackstone's domestic real estate funds, including investments for Blackstone Real Estate Partners I, II, III and IV. Prior to joining Blackstone in 1995, Mr. Orbuch was an Associate in the Real Estate Department at Goldman, Sachs & Co. Prior to joining Goldman, Sachs & Co., Mr. Orbuch was an attorney at Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom, where he specialized in corporate and partnership taxation. Mr. Orbuch graduated summa cum laude from the University of Pennsylvania and received his J.D. from Columbia University, where he was a Stone Scholar.

Nicholas Hecker is a Senior Principal at OZRE, where he is involved in all aspects of OZRE's business, including fundraising, acquisitions, and asset management. Mr. Hecker is a member of OZRE's Investment Committee. Mr. Hecker oversees OZRE's activities in the gaming sector and has also made investments for OZRE in the distressed residential, retail, and hotel sectors. 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Below are biographies of key members of the Applicant's consultant, Global Gaming Consulting, LLC.

John Elliott – Chief Executive Officer, Global Gaming Solutions

John is a corporate executive with a depth of experience in finance, operations and business strategy. He worked with leading global products industry organizations for some 20 years and has nine years in the gaming industry.

John began his career in Andersen Asia Pacific in 1980. He became an audit Partner in the global firm in 1990, becoming a founding Partner in the Andersen business consulting practice in 1993. He held various executive positions including Managing Partner Consulting Australia and finally Chief Operating Officer Andersen Business Consulting Asia Pacific in 2000, where he was responsible for all countries in Asia. John consulted with multinational organizations on operational strategy, implementation of technology and organizational change initiatives. In 2002 he migrated to the U.S. running a global boutique consulting firm in New Jersey, UMS Group, specializing in asset management.

In 2005 John joined the Chickasaw Nation as CFO of the Division of Commerce. John was in this role when Riverwind Casino was built and opened and major expansions undertaken on WinStar World Casino. He was responsible for a large shared services accounting function for all properties, procurement, compliance, treasury management, all aspects of financial planning and analysis, management and financial reporting, operational and capital budgeting for all Division of Commerce businesses. These included at the time 17 gaming properties, retail operations, several hotels, manufacturing and other interests. During this time the Bally's slot system and a number of other major systems, including new human resources and financial systems, were implemented.

In 2008 John started Global Gaming Solutions LLC as a part of the diversification strategy of the Chickasaw Nation. Global acquired Remington Park in Oklahoma City in 2010 via a 363 bankruptcy acquisition process and Lone Star Park in Grand Prairie, Texas in 2011. John is CEO of Global Gaming Solutions today. Global Gaming significantly enhanced the gaming operation of Remington Park improving profitability substantially, building and opening new restaurants and customer service amenities. At Lone Star Park major renovations were also undertaken including a complete rebuild of the simulcast facility, now recognized as one of the finest in the US.

John has a Bachelor of Financial Administration from the University of New England, Australia, a Masters of Business Administration from the Australian Graduate School of Management, University of NSW and is an Associate of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Australia. John and his family are US Citizens.
