

Exhibit VI.L. - Public Officials**Mohegan Sun at The Concord**

Submit as Exhibit VI. L. a list of names, titles, addresses and telephone numbers of any Public Officials or officers or employees of any governmental entity, and Immediate Family Member(s) of said Public Officials, officers or employees, who, directly or indirectly, own any financial interest in, have any beneficial interest in, are the creditors of, hold any debt instrument issued by, or hold or have an interest, direct or indirect, in any contractual or service relationship with the Applicant, the Manager or their Affiliates. Also submit a statement listing all persons and entities not listed in the immediately preceding sentence who or that have any arrangement, written or oral, to receive any compensation from anyone in connection with the Application, the RFA process or obtaining of a License from the State, describing the nature of the arrangement, the service to be provided and the amount of such compensation, whether actual or contingent.

Tonio Burgos – Former public official who now owns and operates Tonio Burgos and Associates, a strategic planning, consulting and lobbying firm. Tonio Burgos has a contract with Concord Associates LP, an affiliate of Concord Kiamesha LLC, to provide strategic planning services for a consulting fee of \$10,000 per month during the RFA process.

Mark Weingarten – A partner at DelBello Donnellan Weingarten Wise & Wiederkehr and a registered NY State lobbyist. Mark has a contract with Concord Associates LP, an affiliate of Concord Kiamesha LLC, to provide strategic planning services for a consulting fee of \$5,000 per month during the RFA process.

Toni Cellini – Former public official who now works at the Monticello Motor Club in Monticello, NY. Mr. Cellini assists Concord Kiamesha in strategic planning and consulting. Mr. Cellini has a contract with Concord Kiamesha LLC, to provide strategic planning services for a consulting fee of \$4,000 per month during the RFA process.

The Mohegan Tribal Gaming Authority (“MTGA”), which, upon award of the license, will own 50.1% of the Applicant and is the indirect owner of 100% of the Manager, is itself a proprietary and governmental instrumentality of the Mohegan Tribe of Indians of Connecticut (the “Mohegan Tribe”) which is a federally-recognized Native American tribe in Connecticut, and itself a governmental entity. The Managers and Officers of the Manager and its affiliates include: Lt. Col. (Retired) Kevin Brown, who is the Chairman of the Mohegan Tribe, and therefore a government official, and David Rome, who is a Justice of the Peace in the State of Connecticut, Town of West Hartford, and therefore a public official. While Chairman Brown received his Commission for the U.S. Army while enrolled at West Point in New York, neither of these officials are present or former public officials of or for the State of New York.
