#### **7. EMPLOYEES**

OCCR Enterprises, LLC. will work with agencies and workforce development commissions in the Orange County and New York area to provide job opportunities for local residents.

There may be some leaders and team members that transfer from Maryland Live Casino to Orange County New York due to preference to get near families in the New York area.

This will allow for better transference of the company culture to the New York site. This might amount to less than 5% of the open positions.

Once hired, OCCR Enterprises, LLC. will train, develop and promote employees to higher levels of responsibility in New York, similar to past practice at Maryland Live Casino.
